Visas for our Spring 2022 students were approved at many US consulates around the world. It takes a long time to get a visa interview.

Act now! Don't wait!

US consulates are prioritizing F1 student visa interviews right now for Fall 2022 admission. You may interview as early as May 8, 2022.



The U.S. consul must, by U.S. law, say: "You're not coming home when you finish your studies."

You must prove that you plan to return permanently to your home country after your studies and post-graduate employment.

Failure to do so is the #1 reason for non-immigrant visa denial.

Be prepared at the interview to explain why you chose Touro GST and how the Touro GST program fits into your career plans.

Be prepared at the interview to explain that you have compelling ties to your home country and that you will return home for your career and to your family.

If your program of study is in great demand in your country, get a letter that they hire people with degrees like the one you will get.



If your family owns a business, take a letter from the bank describing the business.


Simply answer the interview questions and present any facts and documents to support your answers.

Do not discuss anything personal. U.S. consular officials are trained to be impersonal.

If your visa is denied, make sure to ask for the official reason why it was denied. Thank the consular official for his or her time. Keep any papers that you are given that documents the denial.


Home | Visas

Student visas remain a top priority for the U.S. Mission to India, and we are making every attempt to facilitate student travel in time for the fall semester. If you have not yet been able to schedule a visa appointment, please keep checking our website, <u>https://ustraveldocs.com/in</u>, for availability. We continue to add additional July and August student visa appointments at posts across India as conditions allow.

Prior to your visa interview, please review your I-20 program start date. Students beginning a new program with a program start date on or after August 1 may travel to the United States up to 30 days prior to the program start date and do not need a national interest exception. Continuing students may also resume their programs on or after August 1, and travel 30 days before their program resumption date. We are unable to approve expedite requests for Fall 2021 students with scheduled appointments in July or August. If your appointment date may result in a potentially late start, please reach out to your school to discuss potential flexibility on program start dates.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: The United States Embassy and Consulate in Abuja and Lagos are currently processing limited student and exchange visitor visas and will begin processing a limited number of tourist visas (B1/B2s) on November 30. We remain unable to resume full nonimmigrant visa services at this time. The Department of State extended the validity of Machine Readable Visa (MRV) fee payments until December 31, 2021 for individuals who paid an MRV fee, but were unable to schedule and/or attend an interview during the suspension of services. If you have an urgent matter and need to travel immediately, please follow the guidance provided at https://www.ustraveldocs.com/ng or +234-1-227-8955 to request an emergency appointment. Waiver of In-Person Interview

The Department of State has authorized consular officers to waive the in-person interview requirement for certain categories of visa applicants through 31 December 2022. This new authorization applies to travelers applying for F, H-1, H-3, H-4, non-blanket L, M, O, P, Q, and academic J visas who were previously issued any type of visa, if they are applying for a visa in their country of nationality or residence. This authorization does not apply to applicants who have a previous refusal that was not subsequently waived or overcome. Adjudicating consular officers may request an in-person interview if additional information is required from applicants.




Fall 2022 and Spring 2023
